

Euston Park – 31 July-1 August

Euston Park near Thetford is one of our most attractive traditional venues and it offers a fine setting for the arenas and cross-country course. A range of obstacles are built in and around trees in the park and use other natural features and, although they are more spread out than at our other sites, they are within walking distance of the stable field.

You can use a bicycle, quad or car to visit the obstacles provided ground conditions permit. The going is sandy and can be soft and tiring. There may be pigs and sheep near the marathon course. No water obstacles or crossings are currently planned.

The stable field will be open from 12pm on Friday. Water, toilets, horse waste facilities are on site: please take all your rubbish home. A catering trailer is booked for both days providing hot and cold snacks and refreshments.

Your dog must remain under control at all times and we must not disturb the game birds or sheep.

Competition A: Dressage - Saturday

Pre-novice, novices – arena 80 x 40m; open classes – 100 x 40m

Pre-novice: BHDTA dressage test pre-novice (2008)

Novice and small pony: BHDTA dressage test novice (2008)

Open singles classes: **BHDTA 1a (2009)** (or BHDTA Novice (2008), FEI 7a (2007) or FEI 9 (2008))*

Open tandems: BHDTA 1a (2009)

Open pony/horse pairs: **BHDTA 1a (2009)** (or FEI test 10/8b)*

Open horse four-in-hands: FEI test 8a

Open pony four-in-hands: FEI test 10

*Pre-novice and novice classes have standing presentation judging before their dressage. *Please indicate clearly on your entry form which dressage test you wish to use otherwise 1a is presumed.*

Competition C: Cones - Saturday

All classes drive the same cones course of up to 20 cones obstacles, times adjusted according to the recommended speed for each class. Please go to the cones course immediately after your dressage as the stewards will be expecting you.

Competition B: Marathon - Sunday

Three sections, up to 15kms with a maximum of 7 obstacles.
