Brief outline for the event:

Class 0 – Single Pony	(7/8)	18 years old & more	148 cm max

Class 3 – Single Pony	(14/15)	18 years old & more	148 cm max
Class 4 – Single Pony	(16/18)	18 years old & more	148 cm max
Class 5 - Ponies Pairs	(14/18)	18 years old & more	148 cm max
Class 6 - Single Horse	(16/18)	18 years old & more	Over 148 cm

**ALL Competitors must be accompanied by a Groom of 18 years and older.**

Age is determined from the beginning of the calendar year in which the Competitor and Groom reach the designated age.

e.g if the child is 13 on 28 October 2011 they are deemed to be 13 for the whole of 2011.

Entry is free for those attending the summer clinic, however if attending this ODE only the entry fee is £40. Entry forms available on the Events page of the EACDG website.

Dressage and Cones to be driven in dressage attire, all competitors and grooms to wear hard hats for all phases. Classes 0 and 1 competitors and grooms to wear body protectors in all phases. Classes 2 – 6 competitors and grooms to wear body protectors in the Derby and Obstacle Cones Driving phases.

Extract from ICKD rules giving details of the Derby:

### *Chapter 3 - COMPETITION B “DERBY” with MARATHON OBSTACLES*

#### **Article 138 - GENERAL**

- 138.01.** The object of Competition B “Derby” is to test the fitness, stamina and training of the horses, and the driving skill, judgment of pace and general horsemanship of the driver.
- 138.02.** This Competition is an Obstacle Cones Driving test mixed with 2 or 3 Marathon Obstacles.
- 138.03.** Cone Obstacles consist only of a single pair of cones and will constitute a single Obstacle.
- 138.04.** A maximum of 3 Marathon Obstacles may be multiples and should be constructed on flat ground.
- Obstacle Cone Driving rules apply while the cones obstacles are driven and Marathon Obstacle Driving rules apply as the horses’ nose passes the entry flags of the obstacle and cease as the horses’ nose passes through the exit flags. From that point Obstacles Cone Driving rules reapply.
- 138.05.** However, with respect to rules for Grooms, Grooms will be allowed to stand on the back step and advise over the whole Derby course.

- Canter is only allowed in a Marathon Obstacle and only trotting on the track of the cone course.

### **Article 139 - Participation**

#### **139.01 Competitor**

- Less formal dress for Competitor and Groom is acceptable, but shorts are not permitted and will be result in the competitor not being allowed to start.(Art.117.6)
- A Safety Hat and Body Protector are compulsory for all Competitors and Grooms.
- The whip can only be used by the driver.( Art.117.4)
- Competitors may not go more than once round the course.

### 139.02 Grooms

- The Groom can remain standing behind the Driver throughout the whole course and can advise the Driver over the whole Derby course.
- Grooms may go round the course more than once.

### 139.03 Vehicle

The same vehicle must be used in competition A,B and C.(Art.118.1.1)

### Obstacle Cones Driving

#### Article 150 COMPETITION C SUMMARY

- A Hard Hat and Body Protector are compulsory for Competitors and Grooms.
- Up to three obstacles can be multiples

- Canter is not allowed and will be penalized after more 4 strides (First incident: 5pts – Second incident: 10pts – Third incident and subsequent incident - 10 penalties ).

You are strongly advised to read a full copy of the latest ICKD Rules 2011 which are published on the BHDTA website in the reference section. These rules have been rewritten since 2009 and this event will be part of the testing process for them. Your co-operation will be much appreciated if there are any anomalies.

Those who have attended the clinic will have a chance to go through the rules prior to the event.
